

## **BATTERY INSTALLATION**


Tov requires two sets of replaceable AAA alkaline batteries. The shell requires 3 AAA batteries, and the mermaid tail requires 2 AAA batteries. Replace batteries when lights become weak. To install batteries, use a Phillips head screwdriver (not included) to open battery door. Remove and set aside. Insert required AAA alkaline batteries as shown. Replace battery cover and screw closed.


**RECOMMENDED:** Use heavy duty AAA batteries, not long life batteries.

ATTENTION: When tightening screws, make sure equal pressure is applied on all screws. Failure to do this may cause water leakage into battery compartment.




- 1. Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.
- 2. Do not use rechargeable batteries.
- 3. Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc), or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
- 4. Never mix old batteries with new batteries (replace all batteries at the same time).
- 5. Be sure to insert batteries with the correct polarities and always follow the toy and battery manufacturer's instruction.
- 6. Remove batteries from product before extended storage.
- 7. Always remove old or dead batteries from the product.
- 8. The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
- 9. Check that the contact surfaces are clean and bright before installing batteries.
- 10. Dispose of old batteries safely.





Hold tail as shown, making sure your skin touches the

sensors on each side of the tail.





Placing the doll under water also causes the tail to light up.

Do not overtwist doll's torso.

Lights automatically turn off to preserve the battery life. For the shell, close and then reopen to turn the lights on again. For the mermaid, take your hand off and reapply. If doll is under the water, take her out and then reimmerse to turn lights on again.

NOTE: When doll is removed from water, it may take a few seconds for the lights to turn off as the water drains from the doll. • NOTE: Very dry hands, such as experienced in a desert climate, may not cause the tail to light up. • NOTE: Drain/rinse/clean/dry all items thoroughly
